2.5 What do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people?

Key Vocabulary

Holy Week

Holy Week is the week of celebrations, remembrances, and rituals which mark the last days of Jesus before he died on the cross and rose again. It starts with Palm Sunday and culminates with Easter Day / Easter Sunday.

salvation

The core belief that when Jesus died, he died to save us from our sins, giving Christians hope that when they do things wrong they can be forgiven, and that when they die they will go to heaven.

sacrifice

To give up something that is valuable to you in order to help another person; the act of killing an animal or person and offering them to a god or gods, or the animal, etc. that is offered. *"Jesus sacrificed himself to save all mankind."*

Eucharist

AKA Communion / Mass / Lord's Supper.

The Christian service, ceremony, or sacrament commemorating the Last Supper, in which bread and wine are consecrated and consumed
