Key Vocabulary

Ibadah	an Arabic word meaning service or servitude. To worship.
Tawhid	The oneness of Allah.
Shahadah	Islamic declaration of faith. There is one god who is Allah and Muhammad is His prophet.
Salah	To pray five times a day.
Sawm	Fasting in the month of Ramadan. The fast is broken by the celebration of Eid ul-Fitr.
Zakah	The giving of alms. Can be spelt zakat.
Hajj	Pilgrimage. Muslim's complete at least one Hajj in their lifetime.
rak'ah	the prescribed movements in salah / different, symbolic prayer positions

The Kaaba is a small stone building in the court of the Great Mosque at Mecca that contains a sacred black stone and is the goal of Islamic pilgrimage and the point toward which Muslims turn in praying
