The subject web below shows some of the
main areas of learning that will be covered
in our class over the Spring term.

Art & Design and Design & Technology

Flexing our **artistic** muscles,
we will start the year painting
a self-portrait, before
exploring **Making Your Mark**
(Drawing) and **Colour Splash**
(Painting). In **DT**, we will think
about Cooking and Nutrition
and compare and taste
different Fruits and
Vegetables. For **Christmas**,
we will make salt-dough

Music

We will be exploring **My
Musical Heartbeat** and
Dance, Sing, Play!

PE

PE will be on **TUESDAY** in
Autumn Term. We will learn
how to work together as a
team, health & wellbeing in
sports, and how to **dance**.

RE

We have two exciting questions to answer
in RE this term. **What do Christians
believe God is like?** and **Who do
Christians say made the world?**

English

To start our journey into **Independent Writing**,
we will read and be inspired by different books.
Our Punctuation and grammar focus will be
using **capital letters** at the start of sentences,
full stops at the end of sentences and using
finger spaces between words.



Science

As scientists, we will consider **Forces
and Space: Seasonal Changes** and
Materials: Everyday Materials. We
will look at how the seasons change,
different weather patterns and then
the properties of different materials.

History

As Historians, we will ask the question; **How am I making History?** We
will develop an understanding of personal chronology, learn more about our
histories and find out what childhood was like for our parents and
grandparents whilst comparing childhood now and childhood in the past.
We will use terms like '**within living memory**' and '**beyond living memory**.'

Geography

Our geography skills will focus on answering
the question, **What is it like here?** We will
look at Bream School on an aerial photograph,
map our classroom and locate features on the
playgrounds, before designing improvements
for our Infants playground.

Phonics

We will continue our Phonics
journey, which was started in
Acorns Class, with **Little
Wandle Letters and Sounds!**



Maths

As mathematicians, we will be
looking at **Place Value** within 10,
Addition and Subtraction within
10 and **Shape (Geometry)**.



PSHE

This term, Harold the Giraffe
and his friends will help us look
at the skills for life which
include **Me and My Relationships**
and how we are **Valuing
Difference**.



Computing

Computing this term will be all about
logging on to and exploring Purple Mash
and **online safety**. We will then learn to
Group and Sort objects and how to
create and use **Pictograms**.

Homework will be set as **2Dos** on **PurpleMash** and as challenges
on **Numbots**. Log-ins will be given to your child at the start of
term. **Reading** - Your child will bring home **2 books a week** -
one which has been matched to their current phonics reading
level, which they will be able to read to you fluently, and one
which they have chosen to read with you for a **love of reading**.
For each read at home, your child will move up the **Reading
Worm** to get a certificate when they reach its head!
