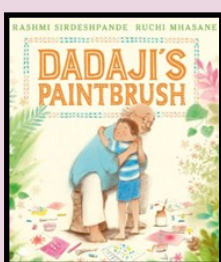
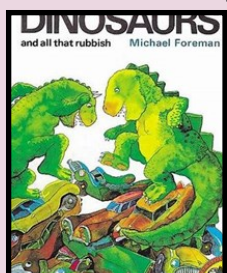


Year 1

Phonics

We will continue our Phonics journey with **Little Wandle Letters and Sounds!**

Science

We will work scientifically to learn about Plants. In **An Introduction to Plants**, we will learn about the key parts of a plant, identifying different plants and recognising deciduous and evergreen trees. We will then be **Making Connections: Investigating science through stories**.

As mathematicians, we will be looking at **Place Value within 100, Multiplication and Division, Fractions** and **Measurement**: money and time.

History
