Art/DT

As Artists, Year 2 will be recapping their skills of sketching as well as developing their skills of mark marking and shading.

In DT children will be exploring mechanisms such as axis and axels. This will take the shape of designing and producing our very own toy cars.

History

As Historians, Year 2 will be comparing schools in the past and compare them to schools now. We will be looking at comparing our own school here in Bream and looking at what has changed over time.

Geography

As Geographers, Beech class will be revisiting and recapping physical and human features. We will also be comparing hot and cold places, identifying the seven continents and identifying physical and human features of two contrasting countries.

PSHE

In class 2, we will be learning about ourselves and what makes us unique. We will be looking at important people in the community and who can help us if we are in trouble.

Science

As scientists, Year 2 will be building on their knowledge of living things and their habitats. This includes understanding what makes something alive and studying different habitats both local and around the world.

English

In English, children will focusing on the books 'The tin forest and 'The way home for wolf.' We will be using these books as a basis for many of our writes including, poems, diary entries and narratives.

In guided reading we will be studying the books 'fairy tale pets' and 'the wardrobe monster'. We will be using our scheme VIPERS to help us get a better understanding of the text.

Music

In music, Year 2 will be learning about tempo and beat. This will involve learning new songs as well playing along with familiar songs.

Computing

Year 2 will be looking at 'online safety' and how to safely search the internet using filters. We will also be looking at coding to create our own stories.

Mathematics

This term we will be looking at the concepts of place value, addition and subtraction.

We will look at counting numbers up to 100, using column addition and subtraction as well as solving problems.

PE

In PE we will be exploring the fundamentals of movement and looking to use basic movements to complete complex routines.

RE

In RE, children will studying Christmas and why it is important to Christians. This will involve understanding the nativity story as well as Christian concepts such as 'incarnation'
