The subject web below shows some of the main areas of learning that will be covered in our class over the Autumn term.

English

We will be using the Rose Blanch book to inspire a narrative based on the experience of a Jewish boy during WW2.

We will study and contrast different poems written about war and use these to inspire our own version.

After half term, we will write a biography of Winston Churchill and will try to replicate the writing style of Tom's Midnight Garden through a diary entry.

History & Geography

We will begin by unpicking some of the causes that led to WW2 and we will try to identify if there was a cause that was more important than others.

We will look at the lives of those who lived through the war and learn about some of the social changes that took place such as the role of women.

In geography, we will learn about some of the different countries involved in WW2, where they are and their connections and trade links now.



Art & D.T

We will study and replicate some of the realism paintings of WW2 battles and landscapes. We will commemorate Remembrance Day by creating modernist poppy art.

In DT, we will be designing and testing a model air raid shelter using a range of different materials.

Science

In science, we will learn about classification of plants and animals and look at the links between adaptation and evolution

Religious Education

In RE, we will be looking at the beliefs and festivals of Hindus and comparing and contrasting to Christian beliefs.
